#### Housekeeping

Just as we began the transition from a member organization, the company who provided the search tool for atransc.org apparently went out of business. Since then, we have installed a new search program that is integrated with atransc.org.

At the same time, the website management program we use stopped working. It had been discontinued by Microsoft years ago but we continued to us it because we knew how and it still worked pretty well. Without a way of repairing the program, we began the process of learning how to use a newer one. As it turned out, the newer program showed that a lot of structural errors had crept into each web page and many of the commands were out of date.

As we write this, the supporting structure of the website has been repaired and updated with the new search tool. Most of the over 400 individual pages should work, and will be updated over time. We hope you have not had too many problems with the site. (Tom's ethericstudies.org is still not updated.)

#### Research

<u>The Energy Profile of Transform EVP</u> research project is still awaiting samples to study. We are looking for Class A examples of **transform** EVP (output file) with examples of the ambient or background sound present at the time of the recording (input file). The files need to be recorded so that they can be synchronized and compared. It is important that we have examples from a number of practitioners. Please see the article.

It is our hope that, once sufficient examples are collected, we will be able to find an independent, academically trained researcher to conduct a study of the energy profiles of synchronized pairs to identify possible differences. Our working assumption is that there will be either a net increase in energy during the EVP or a "bunching" of energy possibly gathered from before and after the utterance from the same sound stream. This information will help us develop a more empirically-based hypothesis for EVP formation.
